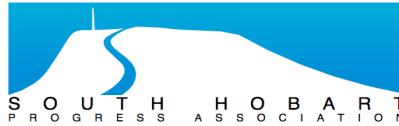

Max Burslem has worked for *Cascade Brewery* for over forty two years. It is due, in large part, to Max's support that the Association was able to conduct the *Bonfire & Fireworks Night* for fifteen years. Max has been very supportive in providing generous assistance from the *Brewery*. Not only did he allow the Association access to the Cascade paddock each year, but also arranged to have the area mown and generally maintained to enable the *Annual Bonfire & Fireworks Night* to proceed. He also arranged for direct and in-kind donations to be paid to subsidise the Event. Max has been as much a part of the identity of the *Cascade Brewery* as the distinctive brew house with Mount Wellington behind it. In recognition of his unstinting service to the South Hobart community, the Association has awarded him its *Eminent Citizen Award for 2012*. The Association, on behalf of the wider community, wishes him well in retirement.

CHAPEL LINK

A South Hobart link is for sale – in the Southern Midlands. Recently advertised for sale has been **St. Mary's Anglican Chapel** at Baden, but in another era it served as the chapel at *Jane Franklin Hall* in Elboden Street. It was there as a chapel for the non-denominational Christian college. A former student resident from the 1960s

recalls having worshipped in it, and remembers it was a lovely unpainted wooden building with a Scandinavian look (it was designed by architect, artist, physician and linguist Dr Edith Emery). It was painted after being moved to Baden in 1970. An SHPA member visited Baden to see the Chapel as it looks now, and it's forlorn in its setting. A local said it had not been used for some time (it has been part of the Southern Midlands Anglican Parish). This local man, who helped in moving it to the site, said it had been obtained for Baden through the determined efforts to the late Rev Nat Sonners. The late Dorothea Henslowe, who mentioned the moving of the chapel to Baden in her book *Our Heritage of Anglican Churches in Tasmania*, wrote that there had been plans to build a church there in 1955 but nothing came of it. The arrival of the small chapel subsequently met those needs. On the occasion of his ninetieth birthday, in 2004, a Tribute to Rev Sonners said he was recorded as a Restoration Parson in the Ross Parish in the 1960s and 1970s because of the "renewal and reinvigoration he encouraged in the parishioners of the Midlands".

DEATH OF PETER BRAIN

Peter was, for many years, a well-known figure at *Salamanca Market*, staffing a stall devoted to peace, the environment, and conservation of Tasmania's built heritage. He was a Director of *Friends of the Wilderness*, which owned the headquarters of the *Wilderness Society* at 130 Davey Street. Peter was also a strong supporter of the *Tasmanian Greens*, standing as a candidate for the Legislative Council in 1992 under the slogan 'Put a Brain into the Legislative Council'. Peter's charm, friendliness, humour, hard work and dedication will be sorely missed.

OATLANDS CENTRE FOR HERITAGE COURSES 2012

In recent times past, conservation and restoration courses on the built heritage of Tasmania were entrusted to one TAFE Certificate IV course - *Conservation of Cultural Heritage Places*, run, on a needs-basis, by former HCC architect, Robert Vincent. Finally, Tasmania has a permanent, industry-based course centred at the **Centre for Heritage at Oatlands**. *The Heritage Education and Skills Course Guide* for 2012 has just been announced. The course includes workshops on the Burra Charter, Researching the History of Your House, Historic Landscapes & Gardens, Basic Repair and Maintenance of Masonry, and more than ten other courses, which run from March to November. The courses are designed for those simply with an interest in built heritage as well as those professionals employed in the industry. Let's hope the courses will ensure that Tasmania has another generation of specialist
